

## ELBEL CLUB CAMPAIGN UPDATE

#### HELP US PROVIDE AN EXPERIENCE OF A LIFETIME!

UMBAA members at BLAST 2014 were updated on the on annual Michigan Marching and Athletic Bands Elbel Club funding from Victors for Michigan Campaign by John W. Stout, '76, the university. and Marianne Swenson '78.

The Elbel Club Victors for Michigan Campaign will complete a \$25 million goal by 2018. As of November 1, 2014 we need just \$9 million to complete endowments for:

- Graduate Student Instruction
- Percussion Instruction
- Flag Instruction
- Instruments
- Student Scholarship Aid

As all of us know first hand, participation in the Marching and Athletic bands provides students with unique opportunities to learn life lessons that reach beyond the boundaries of the academic environment. Many of our alumni report using leadership, teamwork, and time management skills learned in the MMB to excel in their current careers. Our mission is to continue to provide students with world-class instruction, valuable life experiences, and unforgettable performances.

To be clear, the Elbel Club **does not** supplant the absolutely vital UMBAA Student Scholarship Program, which provides much needed support to the students of the University Bands. While the Elbel Club does have scholarships endowed by numerous generous donors, Elbel Club also supports the vital material components of the program such as uniforms, instruments and instructional support, areas not supported by UMBAA scholarship funds.

**You** will have a hand in making sure our students receive the instruction, instruments, and scholarships they need for years to come.

Private support is critical in continuing to provide these outstanding opportunities. YOUR active involvement not only benefits the students and faculty who continue our great MMB traditions, but will also provide the resources needed to pass on these life-changing experiences to the next generation.

Once achieved, fully endowing the Marching and Athletic Band program vastly reduces dependency

on annual funding from the university. Currently, donors contribute nearly 70% of the annual budget for the Marching and Athletic Bands, the remainder covered by university funds.

There are 4,700 living MMB & Athletic Bands Alumni. SEVEN PERCENT of our band alumni are currently donors to the program. To illustrate where we need to be to meet our goals, it's important to note that the national average of alumni giving for the top
