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- 1. August 24th Report Out 235 students and staff attended, down from 290 last year. 15 volunteers. Amount of pizza was perfect. Beverages—ran out of Gatorade, too much pop. Ran out of veggies, still had fruit and desserts left. Well organized event and ran well. Lifting beverage tubs onto tables (instead of leaving on floor), less ice, and name badges instead of stickers would be other suggestions for next year. Side salads for those with dietary restrictions would be nice. Will check with Maggie on this next year, she should know who in MMB has dietary restrictions.

 - 1. Should current students be added to database? We feel our communication is best sent to graduates, not current students. First contact at Spring Meeting would probably be most effective. Diana will speak with Sheri and Roseanne to see how they come about the lists. Diana thinks the Alumni Association may go through the Registrar to get class rosters, and students in bands are registered for it as a class, so this may be an easy way to obtain accurate rosters.
 - iii. Web Site Update (Jason): Reviewed how helpdesk system works, showed how auto renew has been tweaked to make it very obvious what is happening, and showed stats from the past week for Blast registration and M Fanfare views, bounce backs, and what article links were viewed. Jason moves to re-confirm that we are a recurring subscription-based membership system with the ability for the user to disable. Tex seconds. Motion passes unanimously. Jason moves to increase the website budget by \$2000 to handle Mail Chimp integration and clean up our database. This will allow us to import and delete members in bulk. This is a one time budget increase. Evelyn seconds. Motion passes unanimously.

- e. Governance Committee (Tex):
 - i. Vote on updates to Policies and Procedures Read through proposed changes to standing rules. Tex moved to accept, Phil seconded. Discussion to amend proposed changes: Section 9.03 (c):
 - 1. Homecoming registration shall start on August 1 with a participation fee to be determined by the Board of Directors.
 - 2. Late registration shall start two weeks before homecoming and continue for the duration of one week. The participation fee during late registration shall equal the face value of one admission ticket to the football game in the endzone. No registrations will be accepted after late registration has closed, which includes on-site registration.
 - 3. Registration shall close one week before Homecoming, or when maximum allotment is reached, whichever occurs first.
 - 4. Refunds shall not be issued once late registration begins.
 - 5. Further in Section 9.03, we will be removing the table outlining committees, because this needs to be updated in the bylaws first, and a bylaws change requires approval of the general membership.
