- 1. Call to Order 7:03 p.m.
- 2. Meeting Minutes Approval: motion to approve, Jim Roach; second, Jim Davis; passed unanimously.

 - b. Update on National Association of Alumni Bands (NAoAB) Next meeting is Sept. 9. Jim Roach will attend and plans to present something about what we (UMBAA) are doing this fall. Kyle will also attend if he can.

Net income was similar to the previous FY, and was somewhat higher than projected in the budget since ensemble expenses (Alumni Pep Band, Concert Band) were not incurred during the pandemic shutdowns. Overall assets have been increasing and we may want to look at how some of the funds could be used.

Guests will use these e-tickets to enter the stadium the same way as any other ticket holders.

What will the music order be, to list on the back of laminated name tags?
